Membership Revenue

Current YTD Actual Membership Revenue income is \$622,300 vs. a Budget of \$553,448. This has produced an increase over budget of \$68,852. February 2024 YTD Membership revenue was \$529,709, which puts FY2025 YTD at an increase over prior year of \$92,591. With the snow in mid/late February, we expect membership revenue to exceed the prior year.

Expense

Expenses are mostly tracking at budget, with the only underbudget variance related to the Trails Gen Expenses. Conversely, Year to date 2025 is tracking over prior year to date (2024) in the same line. This line is offset by grant revenue in the revenue section of the financials, and varies based on when expenses are expensed/paid.
